- 1. Since *Dr. Michael*, KI5UNQ, with *Jerry Boyd*, KI5TPV, suggested setting up a ham group to two hams, the development has been phenomenal.   - a. *Ashley*, KI5TBB, is **Ham Class Instruction**. The present team is Russ, Joyce, Rusty, Lt. Col. Dan, and Dr. Marc. It is awesome to see people going from no knowledge to active ham. Is this your place?
  - b. *Jerry*, KI5ZRB, is **AllStar Nodes**. This is a very cool, important part for our ham radio system, since the little nodes intertie our repeaters, radios, and phones. It is a little Pi, a little Wi-Fi, and a barrel of fun. Are you curious or interested in building, using, and networking nodes?
  - c. *Rusty*, KJ5AND, is **Project Coordination** for repeaters and other big projects. With five projects underway, he is juggling. The present team is Russ, Richard, Chuck, and Dr. Marc. Are you construction project savvy?
  - d. *Mark*, K5LGS, is **Sho-n-Tell** coordination. His team is Scooter, Russ, Dr. Marc, and YOU. What are your ideas for Sho-n-Tell? Are you interested in showing or telling or helping others do or make?
  - e. *Russ*, N5IRU, is **Engineering and Technology** development. He makes sure what we are doing is technically kosher. He keeps the repeaters going. The present team is Dr. Marc. Are you an engineer with relevant skills?
  - f. *Brett*, KI5TAX, is **Website and Social-Media**. He is managing over 160 articles on the web, with two or three changes each week. Do you have creative skills, media skills, or web skills?
  - g. *Chris*, KI5ZDE, is **Net** coordinator. The team is Russ, Brett, Lt. Col. Dan, Joyce, Richard, Ashley, and Tim. Are you interested in doing net control, promoting the nets, or starting a new net, such as Youth or HF or ...? Are you interested in an alternate like Thursday once a month or additional night for the net, for those who cannot make Monday?
  - h. *Kathryn*, KI5TAT, is **Just for Newbies** coordination. Helping folks getting started is an incredibly valuable resource. We were all there. This is encouragement, answering questions, and showing where info is available, like articles and soon to be videos. Getting them to talk on your radio. Technical skill not required. Do you want to mentor?
  - i. *Lt. Col. Dan*, K5CAY, is **Testing, Licensing, and Repeater** site coordination. The team members require ARRL VE certification. The present are Russ, Joyce, Ashley, Larry, Brett, Marty, and Dr. Marc. Are you an Extra?
  - j. *Dr. Marc*, NM0D, and *Rosemary*, KE5CMS, are **Research Scientist and Weekly Articles**. These articles come from your questions and requests. If one person has a question, we know someone else likely has a similar quandary. With the wide range of experience, interests, and queries within the group, this is just plain fun, challenging, and enlightening. From basics to rocket science, what an awesome group. Do you have a question?
  - k. *Lt. Col. Dan* and *Dr. Marc* are **Founder** Elmers providing advice, counsel, and direction. Are you financially gifted and want to help?
